



DETERMINE THE RIGHT RING SIZE

Read and print these step-by-step instructions for accurate measurements that will ensure you get the right ring at the right size!

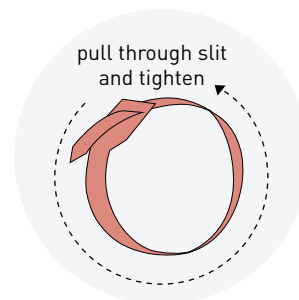
- In the print settings, adjust the page scaling to “none”
- Measure the bar on top: it must be exactly 2 inches or 50mm on a ruler
- If the measurement seems inaccurate, ensure you’re printing the page at full size and print again as necessary

MEASUREMENT OPTION 1: USING THE RING SIZER

- Cut along the outline of the ring sizer. Make a small slit in the left end of the sizer.
- Wrap the sizer around the intended finger. The numbers should be facing out.
- Slide the pointed end of the sizer through the slit you made.
- Move the sizer to the knuckle of the finger.
- Tightly pull the sizer, ensuring it fits comfortably but snugly.
- The ring size is represented by the number that lines up at the slit of the sizer.

Take note:

- Avoid measuring your fingers when it feels cold or is in a cold environment.
- Preferably take the measurement at night, when fingers are more likely to be at their largest size.

MEASUREMENT OPTION 2: MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

- Find a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
- Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement represents the diameter of the ring.
- If the ring falls between two sizes, it is recommended to get the larger size.
